The Glux represents an attempt at an intercultural lucky charm. It is based on the research of lucky charms from different cultures all over the world. Its round basic form is protective on the one hand and useful on the other. Its core, a ball inside a cavity, is hidden from view, but you can feel the movement of the ball inside when the Glux is shaken. In the centre of the Glux is the act of giving, the mysterious inside serving as a projection surface. The person who gives the Glux away focuses on projecting positive wishes for its recipient, and then the "supercharged" object is given to the recipient.

The lucky charm is effective because the owner knows about the good wishes made by the donor, which are represented by the core. Depending on the faith of the owner, the Glux is like other lucky charms, but it works without being connected with a specific religion.
