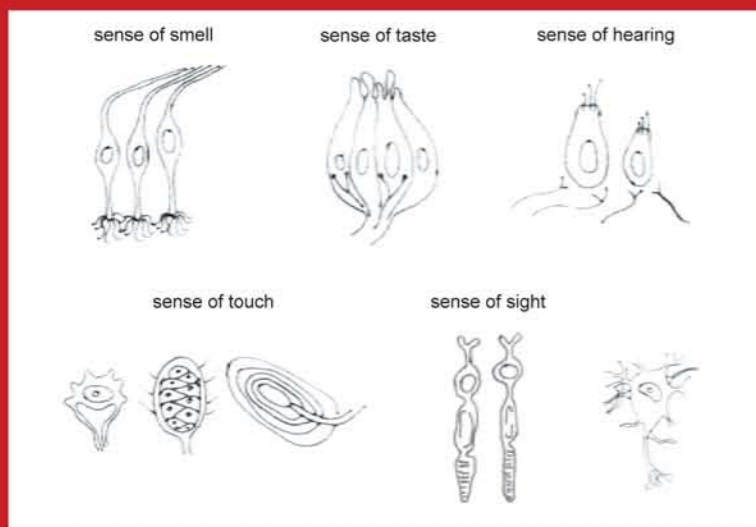




The picture displays the “scientifically” / “knowledge-orientated” background.
