Materials: Copper, beads from buddist /hindoeist prayer beads Price: € 1200,-

The object, a necklace, represent different religions and explore the idea of faith. The necklace consists of two copper plates on which I have etched a Christian scene and an Islamic scene; Buddhist prayer beads made out of carved bone skulls connect the plates. When the necklace is worn there is a balance between the two images, neither coming to the fore. The copper has been treated to retain its discolouration but is resistant to further oxidization. It is very important that the religious elements are not immediately obvious; as no particular element stands out you can see the commonalities rather than the differences.
